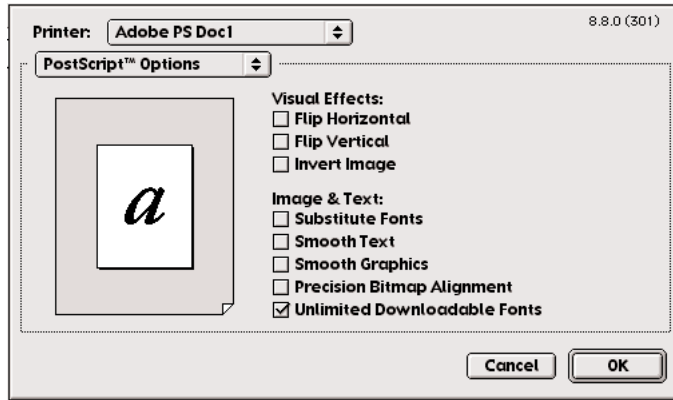
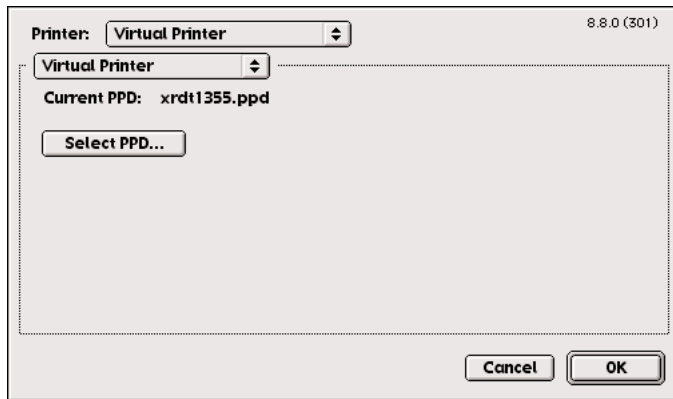


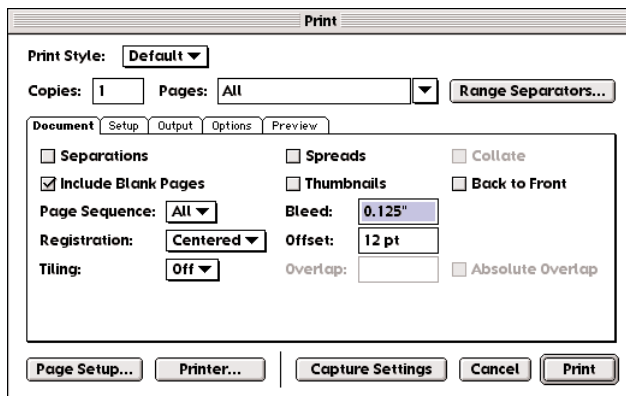
## Creating a Postscript file (.ps) using the Adobe Postscript Driver in Quark Express.



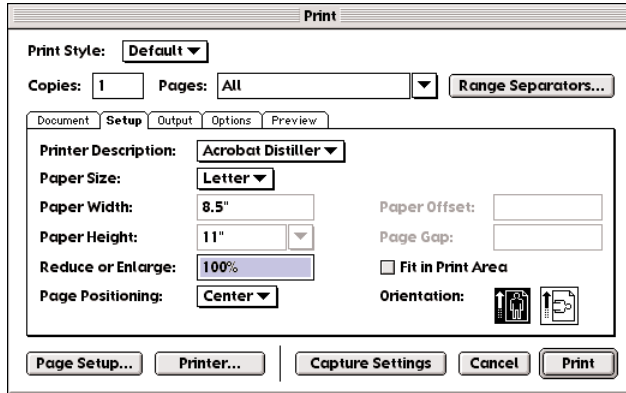
In Page Setup, make sure to have all options unchecked except for “Unlimited Downloadable Fonts.”



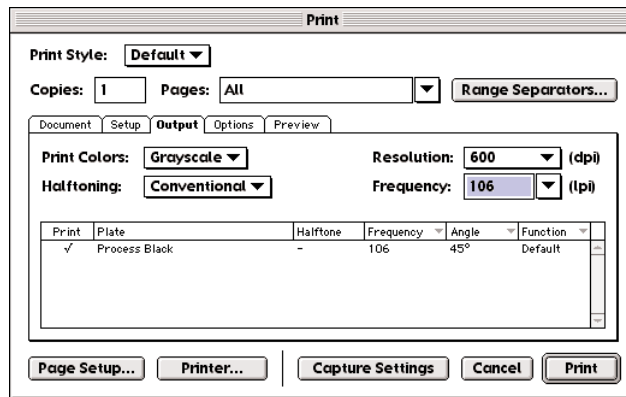
If using Virtual Printer, then choose the Xerox Docutech 135 PPD (available for download).



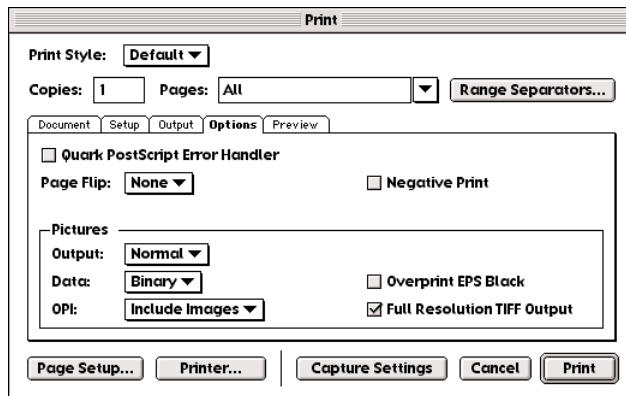
For 5.5 x 8.5 and 6 x 9 books, use registration marks set at 12pt. Please set bleed at .125” (1/8). Also, please make sure to include blank pages.



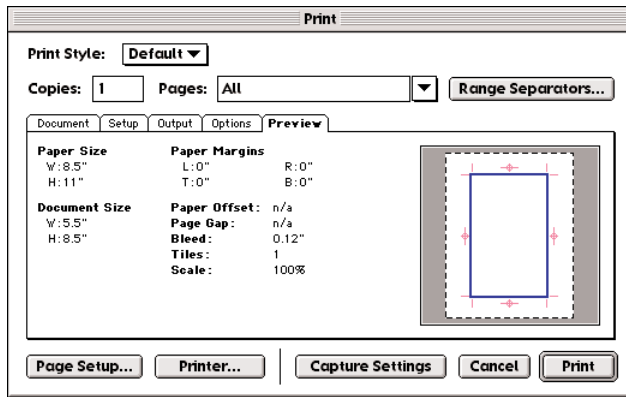
For a general printer, Adobe's Distiller works well. Set the page size to 8.5 x 11, and center the text within the page.



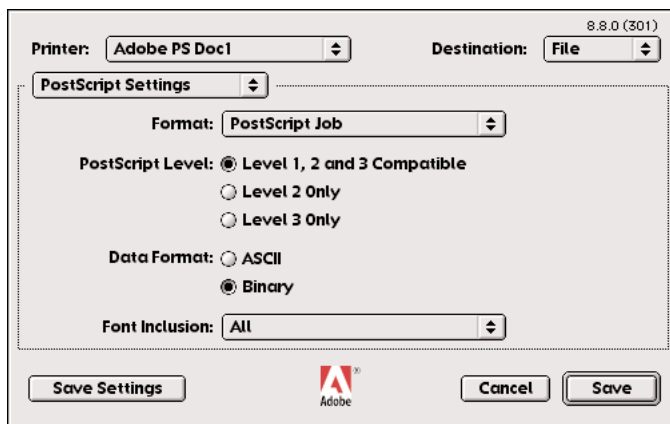
Set Print Colors to "Grayscale" and use Conventional Halftoning. This allows you to change the Frequency (106lpi). Also, be sure to have the Resolution set to 600dpi.



For Pictures, have the Output set to "Normal", Data set to "Binary", OPI to "Include Images", and "Full Resolution TIFF Output".



Check Preview to make sure everything is set right.



Change the Destination to "File", and change the Postscript Level to "1, 2, and 3", with Data Format as "Binary", and Font Inclusion set to "All".
